- b. Elaborate the elements of contract involved in this case.

- Q. 3: X agreed to give his land to a school for the library on the condition that the library would be named after him. The management agreed to the condition but later on X changed his mind. Could the management enforce the contract? Justify with reasons.
- Q. 4: A bets B that in wrestling if first wrestler wins he will pay B Rs. 1000 while B bets the same in favor of second wrestler. What type of contract it is? Elaborate with reasons.

- Q. 6. A agrees to pay B Rs. 1000 if B marries C but C marries F. Subsequently F dies and B marries C. B sues A for the payment of Rs. 1000. Decide the validity of this case with reasons.
